



## Schedule of Fees

Fee for the Assessment for Migration – Desktop Assessment	
<u>Application for Assessment for Migration</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The outcome from this assessment is valid for three years.</li> <li>The receipt for payment of the fee must be submitted with the application.</li> <li>This fee is non-refundable.</li> <li>A new application and fee of A\$800 is required if the current Assessment for Migration outcome expires.</li> </ul>	A\$800
Fee for the Assessment of Competence through Supervised Practice	
<u>Application for Assessment of Competence</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The receipt for payment of the fee must be submitted with the application.</li> <li>This fee is non-refundable.</li> <li>Should there be a change in circumstance, i.e. change in location or practice, a new application is required. However, a second fee is not required if the application is within 12 months of the submission of the previous application. If the practitioner starts a new Assessment of Competence application after 12 months, a second fee of A\$1500 is required.</li> <li>If the OTC withdraws from the assessment and the practitioner starts a new Assessment of Competence, a new application and fee of A\$1500 will be required.</li> </ul>	A\$1500
<u>Application for Assessment of Competence for applicants who completed Stage 1 Assessment prior to 27 October 2025</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>These applicants are eligible for the \$300 cultural responsiveness training refund once the Assessment of Competence Certificate has been issued.</li> <li>The receipt for payment of the fee must be submitted with the application.</li> <li>This fee is non-refundable.</li> <li>Should there be a change in circumstance, i.e. change in location or practice, a new application is required. However, a second fee is not required if the application is within 12 months of the submission of the previous application. If the practitioner starts a new Assessment of Competence application after 12 months, a second fee of A\$1000 is required.</li> <li>If the OTC withdraws from the assessment and the practitioner starts a new Assessment of Competence, a new application and fee of A\$1000 will be required.</li> </ul>	A\$1000

Level 1 appeal (IQC)	A\$600
Level 2 appeal (IAP)	A\$600
